**AS PASSED SENATE**

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4,  
 2 1991 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, so as to prohibit the mayor and councilmembers  
 3 from holding any other elective or appointive office in the city or otherwise be employed by  
 4 said government or any agency thereof during the term for which that official was elected;  
 5 to prohibit any former mayor or former councilmember from holding any appointive office  
 6 in the city or being employed by the city until one year after the expiration of the term for  
 7 which that official was elected; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and  
 8 for other purposes.

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

10 **SECTION 1.**

11 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4, 1991  
 12 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (e) of Section 2.16  
 13 as follows:

14 "(e) Except where authorized by law, neither the mayor nor any councilmember shall hold  
 15 any other elective or appointive office in the city or otherwise be employed by said  
 16 government or any agency thereof during the term for which that official was elected. No  
 17 former mayor and no former councilmember shall hold any appointive office in the city or  
 18 be employed by the city until one year after the expiration of the term for which that  
 19 official was elected."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
