- 14 Authority, American Legion Post #124, and VFW Post #6442; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason and a member of Al Sihah Shrine
- 16 Center, National Funeral Directors Association, Georgia Academy of Graduate Embalmers,
- 17 and Georgia Funeral Directors Association; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. Mathews was a member of Montezuma
- 19 United Methodist Church and the Baracca Sunday School Class; and
- 20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
- 21 American be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.
