AS PASSED SENATE

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act establishing the State Court of Wayne County (formerly the City Court of
2 Jesup, in and for the County of Wayne), approved July 31, 1916 (Ga. L. 1916, p. 248), as
3 amended, particularly by an Act approved April 28, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4563), so as to
4 change the salary of the judge and solicitor; to provide for related matters; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act establishing the State Court of Wayne County (formerly the City Court of Jesup, in
9 and for the County of Wayne), approved July 31, 1916 (Ga. L. 1916, p. 248), as amended,
10 particularly by an Act approved April 28, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4563), is amended by
11 revising Section 3 as follows:

12 "Section 3. The judge of the State Court of Wayne County shall be paid an annual salary
13 equal to the sum of 90 percent of the annual salary, including base salary and all county
14 supplements, of a judge of the superior court. Such salary shall be paid in monthly
15 installments from the funds of Wayne County at the direction of the board of
16 commissioners of Wayne County."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 4 as follows:

19 "Section 4. The solicitor of the State Court of Wayne County shall be paid an annual salary
20 equal to the sum of 90 percent of the annual salary, including base salary and all county
21 supplements, of a judge of the superior court. Such salary shall be paid in monthly
22 installments from the funds of Wayne County at the direction of the board of
23 commissioners of Wayne County."

SECTION 3.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
