A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Jesse Rouse and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Jesse Rouse served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with
4 the United States Armed Forces; and

5 WHEREAS, a leader in Lincoln County, Mr. Rouse served as president of the Twilight
6 Improvement Association, a clearing-house for the presentation, review, and study of
7 problems facing the citizens of Lincoln County, Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, under Mr. Rouse's leadership and guidance, the Twilight Improvement
9 Association received federal funds for emergency food and medical services for residents of
10 Lincoln County; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Rouse organized a senior citizens program and established a transportation
12 program for senior citizens in the county; and

13 WHEREAS, he was responsible for acquiring scholarship funding for six local college
14 students and organized several voter registration drives and voter forums; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on Highway 79 over Fishing Creek in Lincoln
19 County is dedicated as the Jesse Rouse Memorial Bridge.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Jesse Rouse Memorial Bridge.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
23 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
24 family of Mr. Jesse Rouse and the Department of Transportation.
