## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Chief Lee E. O'Dillon for 30 years of service to the City of Watkinsville; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on March 23, 1986, Chief Lee E. O'Dillon became the sole police officer and  
4 Chief of Police for the City of Watkinsville and has held that position ever since; and

5 WHEREAS, as a young person, he worked at WNGC-FM radio and WDOL-AM radio as a  
6 disc jockey; and

7 WHEREAS, he became post certified and worked with the Clarke County Sheriff's office,  
8 where he served as jailer, and later served at the Oconee County Sheriff's Office under the  
9 direction of Sheriff Charles Holcomb; and

10 WHEREAS, he is a life-long resident of the City of Watkinsville and Oconee County, where  
11 he grew up attending the county schools; and

12 WHEREAS, Chief O'Dillon is certainly among the oldest, if not the oldest, serving Police  
13 Chief in North Georgia; and

14 WHEREAS, Chief O'Dillon has exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding  
15 loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties, and his efficient  
16 and effective commitment to excellence should be commended.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body recognize Chief Lee E. O'Dillon for 30 years of service to the City  
19 of Watkinsville and express their best wishes for continued health and happiness.
