**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To repeal an Act entitled "An Act to repeal an Act entitled 'An Act to provide for a budget
2 in all counties in this State having a population of two hundred thousand or more by the
3 United States census of 1930, or by any future census; to define the word 'authorities' as used
4 herein; for the publication of the proposed budget, the adoption of the budget and publication
5 of the final budget as adopted... and for other purposes' approved March 16, 1939, appearing
6 in Georgia Laws 1939, pp. 272-276, and all Acts amendatory thereto; and for other
7 purposes," approved March 2, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2815), and all Acts amendatory thereto;
8 to provide for the nonrevival of a previously repealed Act; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
9 other purposes.

10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

11 **SECTION 1.**

12 An Act entitled "An Act to repeal an Act entitled 'An Act to provide for a budget in all
13 counties in this State having a population of two hundred thousand or more by the United
14 States census of 1930, or by any future census; to define the word 'authorities' as used herein;
15 for the publication of the proposed budget, the adoption of the budget and publication of the
16 final budget as adopted... and for other purposes' approved March 16, 1939, appearing in
17 Georgia Laws 1939, pp. 272-276, and all Acts amendatory thereto; and for other purposes,"
18 approved March 2, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2815), and all Acts amendatory thereto are hereby
19 repealed.

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 The repeal of Act No. 350, approved March 2, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2815), as provided by
22 Section 1 of this Act shall not have the effect of reviving Act No. 194, approved March 16,
23 1939 (Ga. L. 1939, p. 272).

SECTION 3.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
