

WITHDRAWN

Senator McKoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Public Safety Committee substitute to SB 6 (LC 41 0756S) by replacing*
 2 *lines 2 through 12 with the following:*

3 drivers' licenses, so as to clarify and provide for persons who may obtain certain licenses,
 4 permits, or cards; to provide for driving safety cards for persons who are current recipients
 5 of grants of deferred action on deportation which shall operate the same as drivers' licenses;
 6 to provide for exceptions; to provide for the design of driving safety cards; to provide for
 7 criminal penalties; to provide for related

8 *By replacing line 18 with the following:*

9 is amended by revising paragraph (15) of Code Section 40-5-1,

10 *By deleting lines 20 through 23.*

11 *By replacing lines 35 through 37 with the following:*

 14 to be present in the United States."

15 *By replacing "driver's privilege card" with "driving safety card" on lines 44, 62, 64 through*
 16 *65, 67, 71, 78, 80, 84, 86, 88, 103, 105, 110, 111, 112 through 113, and 114.*

17 *By replacing "deferred action" with "deferred action on deportation" on lines 61, 79, 99, 161,*
 18 *and 163.*

19 *By replacing lines 90 through 96 with the following:*

20 (B) A driving safety card shall bear the legend: 'The individual shown hereon has
 21 passed the driving skills, knowledge, and vision tests required by state law.' A driving
 22 safety card shall, in white letters displayed on a black banner positioned at the top or
 23 bottom, or both, of the driving safety card, include the terms 'DRIVING SAFETY
 24 CARD', 'NOT FOR IDENTIFICATION', 'NO LAWFUL STATUS', and 'NOT
 25 ACCEPTABLE FOR OFFICIAL PURPOSES'. The driving safety card shall have a
 26 vertical orientation. Other than as provided for in this paragraph, a driving safety card

27 shall contain the same physical characteristics of, and be similar in form to, a driver's
 28 license issued by the department.

29 *By replacing lines 100 and 101 with the following:*

30 (a.2) No person who is a current recipient of a grant of deferred action on deportation from
 31 the United States Department of Homeland Security shall be eligible to obtain a driver's
 32 license; provided, however, that any person who is a current recipient of such grant of
 33 deferred action on deportation and who has a valid driver's license shall, upon

51 *By replacing lines 189 through 200 with the following:*

52 (1) The department shall attempt to confirm through the SAVE program that the
 53 applicant is lawfully present in the United States; and
 54 (2) If the SAVE program does not provide sufficient information to the department to
 55 make a determination, the department shall be authorized to accept verbal ~~or~~, e-mail, or
 56 other means of confirmation of the legal status of the applicant from the Department of
 57 Homeland Security."

58 "(e) A person determined to be a current recipient of a grant of deferred action on
59 deportation from the United States Department of Homeland Security pursuant to this Code
60 section shall be eligible for a driving safety card as provided for in subsection (a.1) of Code
61 Section 40-5-20."

62 *By deleting Section 7 and redesignating Sections 8 and 9 as Sections 7 and 8, respectively.*
