

ADOPTED

Senator McKoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Public Safety Committee substitute to SB 6 (LC 41 0756S) by replacing*
 2 *lines 2 through 12 with the following:*

3 drivers' licenses, so as to clarify and provide for persons who may obtain certain licenses,
 4 permits, or cards; to provide for driving safety cards for persons who are current recipients
 5 of grants of deferred action on deportation which shall operate the same as drivers' licenses;
 6 to provide for exceptions; to provide for the design of driving safety cards; to provide for
 7 special identification cards for persons who are current recipients of grants of deferred action
 8 on deportation; to provide for the design of such special identification cards; to provide for
 9 criminal penalties; to provide for related

10 *By replacing line 18 with the following:*

11 is amended by revising paragraph (15) of Code Section 40-5-1,

12 *By deleting lines 20 through 23 and replacing lines 35 through 37 with the following:*

13 chapter unless such person is either a United States citizen or an alien ~~with legal~~
 14 authorization from the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service having lawful status
 15 to be present in the United States."

16 *By replacing "driver's privilege card" with "driving safety card" on lines 44, 62, 64, 65, 67,*
 17 *71, 78, 80, 84, 86, 88, 103, 105, and 110 through 114.*

18 *By replacing "deferred action" with "deferred action on deportation" on lines 61, 79, 99, 161,*
 19 *and 163.*

20 *By replacing lines 90 through 96 with the following:*

21 (B) A driving safety card shall bear the legend: 'The individual shown hereon has
 22 passed the driving skills, knowledge, and vision tests required by state law.' A driving
 23 safety card shall, in white letters displayed on a black banner positioned at the top or
 24 bottom, or both, of the driving safety card, include the terms 'DRIVING SAFETY
 25 CARD', 'NOT FOR IDENTIFICATION', 'NO LAWFUL STATUS', and 'NOT
 26 ACCEPTABLE FOR OFFICIAL PURPOSES'. The driving safety card shall have a
 27 vertical orientation. Other than as provided for in this paragraph, a driving safety card

28 shall contain the same physical characteristics of, and be similar in form to, a driver's
 29 license issued by the department.

30 *By replacing lines 100 and 101 with the following:*

31 (a.2) No person who is a current recipient of a grant of deferred action on deportation from
 32 the United States Department of Homeland Security shall be eligible to obtain a driver's
 33 license or a special identification card other than a special identification card provided for
 34 under subsection (d) of Code Section 40-5-21.1; provided, however, that any person who
 35 is a current recipient of such grant of deferred action on deportation and who has a valid
 36 driver's license or special identification card other than a special identification card
 37 provided for under subsection (d) of Code Section 40-5-21.1 shall, upon expiration of such
 38 driver's license or special identification card, be subject to the provisions of this chapter
 39 relating to a driving safety card or special identification card."

40 *By replacing line 127 with the following:*

41 (a) Except as provided in subsections (a.1) and (a.2) of Code Section 40-5-20,
 42 notwithstanding ~~Notwithstanding~~ any other provision of this title, an applicant who
 43 presents in person

44 *By replacing lines 133 through 139 with the following:*

45 (5) Approved deferred action on deportation status;
 46 (6) Other federal documentation verified by the United States Department of Homeland
 47 Security to be valid documentary evidence of lawful presence in the United States under
 48 federal immigration law; or
 49 (7) Verification of lawful presence as provided by Code Section 40-5-21.2
 50 may be issued a temporary license, permit, or special identification card. Such temporary
 51 license, permit, or special

52 *By replacing lines 144 through 146 with the following:*

53 persons not lawfully present in the United States may not be accepted as evidence of legal
 54 presence in the United States.
 55 (c) Any noncitizen applicant whose Georgia

56 *By replacing lines 177 and 178 with the following:*

57 identification card, include the terms 'NO LAWFUL STATUS' and 'NOT
 58 ACCEPTABLE FOR OFFICIAL PURPOSES'. Other than as provided for in this

59 *By replacing lines 189 through 200 with the following:*

60 (1) The department shall attempt to confirm through the SAVE program that the
61 applicant is lawfully present in the United States; and

62 (2) If the SAVE program does not provide sufficient information to the department to
63 make a determination, the department shall be authorized to accept verbal ~~or~~, e-mail, or
64 other means of confirmation of the legal status of the applicant from the Department of
65 Homeland Security."

66 "(e) A person determined to be a current recipient of a grant of deferred action on
67 deportation from the United States Department of Homeland Security pursuant to this Code
68 section shall be eligible for a card as provided for in subsection (a.1) of Code Section
69 40-5-20 or subsection (d) of Code Section 40-5-21.1."

70 *By deleting Section 7 and redesignating Sections 8 and 9 as Sections 7 and 8, respectively.*
