- 18 "When You Must Go to Municipal Court," an in-service training manual for the Atlanta
- 19 Police Department, and a proposal for a "Drug Free Fulton County," which helped to
- 20 establish a comprehensive drug plan as an alternative to institutionalization; and
- 21 WHEREAS, she has received numerous awards, a few of which include the Outstanding
- Woman Achiever in the Judiciary Award in 1990, the Gate City Bar Association Award, the
