A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Steven Douglas Wyckoff for his efforts and hard work in Eagle Scout Troop
2 27; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Steven Douglas Wyckoff, a native Georgian raised in Johns Creek, is a senior
4 at Johns Creek High School who plans to attend Kennesaw State University; and

5 WHEREAS, a scout since February 2009, Steven received his Eagle Scout Award on August
6 25, 2015, as a member of Troop 27, which meets at Johns Creek Christian Church and is also
7 partnered with the Boy Scouts of America, Atlanta Area Council; and

8 WHEREAS, Steven's community service project involved the Autrey Mill Nature Center's
9 outdoor stage; leading and organizing a group of 145 volunteers, he used the patrol method
10 to remove the existing boardwalk and replace it with a wooden staircase containing three
11 steps, which can also serve as seating that runs the 20-foot length of the front of the stage;

13 WHEREAS, the existing boardwalk and stairs were retrofitted into a handicap-accessible
14 ramp; and

15 WHEREAS, he spent \$397.58 for materials and supplies to construct the steps and ramps;

17 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
18 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend Steven Douglas Wyckoff for exuding great leadership,
21 reverence, and loyalty to achieve this outstanding accomplishment and for excelling at the

22 challenge of being involved in his troop, school, church, and community and congratulate
23 him on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
