A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Representative Robert "Bob" Bryant; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
4 with the passing of Representative Robert "Bob" Bryant on February 25, 2016; and

5 WHEREAS, Representative Robert "Bob" Bryant was born in Savannah, Georgia, on August
6 11, 1944, to the late Mr. James C. and Rosa Bryant; and

7 WHEREAS, upon graduating from Sophronia Tompkins High School in 1962, he enlisted
8 in the United States Army and retired as a Sergeant First Class after 20 years of service; and

9 WHEREAS, upon receiving a Bachelor of Science degree in Business from Columbia
10 College, Representative Bryant was employed by the City of Savannah and also served as
11 general manager for WEAS radio station; and

12 WHEREAS, he was a dedicated public servant and consistently worked to improve the
13 Garden City, Savannah, and Chatham County region by first serving as president of the
14 Garden City Progressive Community Organization and then getting elected to the City
15 Council of Garden City and serving as Mayor Pro Tem for two terms; and

16 WHEREAS, Representative Bryant was elected into the Georgia House of Representatives
17 in 2004 to serve the constituents of District 162 and was serving his twelfth year when he
18 passed; and

19 WHEREAS, in his spare time, he would deejay at weddings, birthdays, and other events; he
20 was the owner and host of the Wax Museum Radio Show and owned and operated Bryant's
21 Transport Services since 1999; and

22 WHEREAS, Representative Bryant was united in love and marriage to his loving and
23 devoted wife of 53 years, Lee, and was blessed with four wonderful children, Andrea, Tony,
24 Robert, and Michael; nine remarkable grandchildren, Brandon, Shawn, Kendall, Bryce,
25 Tannishala, Kynnedi, Michaela, Maya, and Megan; and one amazing great-grandchild,
26 Destinee; and

27 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Representative Bryant will long be
28 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and public service and will be missed by all
29 who had the great fortune of knowing him.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
31 honor the life and memory of Representative Robert "Bob" Bryant and express their deepest
32 and most sincere regret at his passing.
