A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Vickie Crowley Pettit; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Mrs. Vickie Crowley Pettit on December 14, 2015; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Pettit was born on June 24, 1952, in Atlanta, Georgia, a beloved daughter
5 of Doris C. Helms and the late Herman Cecil Crowley; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a 1974 graduate of the University of Georgia, she first worked in Washington,
7 D.C., for Senator Herman Talmadge, and was later employed at Cobb EMC where for 32
8 years she served there in customer service and public relations; she was also a lobbyist at the
9 Georgia General Assembly for ten years prior to her retirement from Cobb EMC in 2009;

- 11 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Pettit was an active member of the
12 Sam Jones United Methodist Church in Cartersville, Georgia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Pettit was united in love and marriage to H. Boyd Pettit III, and was
14 blessed with two remarkable children, Victoria and Dana, and three wonderful grandchildren,
15 Trip, Taff, and Taryn; and
- 16 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
17 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
18 her family and friends were admired by others; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
20 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
21 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Mrs. Pettit will long be remembered for
23 her love of family and friendship and this loyal daughter, wife, mother, grandmother, and
24 friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 join in honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Vickie Crowley Pettit and express their deepest
27 and most sincere regret at her passing.
