WHEREAS, in his reserve assignments, Captain Edge has served as Director of the United States Navy Central Command and United States Fifth Fleet Reserve Public Affairs Unit in Quincy, Massachusetts; Executive Officer of United States Fleet Forces Command Public Affairs Reserve Unit in Norfolk, Virginia; and Director of United States Navy Europe and United States Sixth Fleet Public Affairs Unit in Marietta, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Captain Edge's military awards include the Legion of Merit, two Defense
Meritorious Service Medals, three Navy Commendation Medals, the Joint Service
Achievement Medal, three Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals, the Afghanistan
