A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Camden County High School Wildcat wrestling team; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Camden County High School Wildcat wrestling team successfully defended
4 both the Class 5-A dual state title and the Class 5-A traditional state title in 2016; and

5 WHEREAS, the Wildcats won the 2016 dual state championship by defeating Woodland
6 High School in the championship round; and

7 WHEREAS, the team earned 268.5 points in the 2016 traditional state championship, which
8 is 81 points more than the next highest scoring team and a new school record; and

9 WHEREAS, twelve members of the Wildcat wrestling team finished in the top four of their
10 individual weight classes at the traditional state championship, also a new school record; and

11 WHEREAS, Raydan Wilder was the champion of the 120-pound weight class and was the
12 first freshman in school history to win his weight class at the traditional state championship;
13 Bunmi Smith, a junior, was the champion of the 160-pound weight class; Antonio Stewart,
14 a junior, was the champion of the 170-pound weight class; Domonique "Chubb" Hargrave,
15 a senior, was the champion of the 182-pound weight class; and Gabe Smith, a senior, was the
16 champion of the 285-pound weight class; and

17 WHEREAS, the Class of 2016 is the most decorated senior class in the history of Camden
18 wrestling, and the 2015-2016 season will be remembered as one of the most successful
19 wrestling seasons in Camden County High School history; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of the
21 Wildcats, who have represented their school and community with great distinction, be
22 appropriately recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend the Camden County High School Wildcat wrestling team for their exemplary
25 accomplishments and wish them many more years of future success.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
27 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
28 Camden County High School Wildcat wrestling team.
