

House Resolution 1606

A RESOLUTION

1 Creating the House Study Committee on the Affordability of Burial Services; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the time following the loss of a loved one is one of the most difficult periods
4 in an individual's life; and

5 WHEREAS, it has been a decade since the General Assembly last reviewed state laws
6 governing cemetery practices and pricing; and

7 WHEREAS, with the cost of funerals, burial sites, cemetery plots, and vaults escalating,
8 cremation has become a growing trend for honoring loved ones after they have passed on;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, it is important that consumers understand their rights when purchasing burial
11 plots, vaults, and other burial and funeral merchandise and that the contracts used and the
12 associated fees are easy to comprehend; and

13 WHEREAS, consumers may lack information about how cremations are performed as well
14 as what laws govern burial plot location and usage of the associated lands; and

15 WHEREAS, the General Assembly needs to study the current laws with a view toward
16 decreasing the potential for monopolistic practices and increasing opportunities for
17 competition; and

18 WHEREAS, there are many service areas relating to the loss of a loved one that need to be
19 examined to ensure that the best interests of the citizens of this state are being served.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

21 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
22 on the Affordability of Burial Services.

23 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
24 House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
25 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
26 of the committee.

27 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
28 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
29 legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.

30 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
31 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
32 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
33 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

34 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
35 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
36 Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
37 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
38 Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
39 appropriated to the House of Representatives.

40 (6) **Report.**

41 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
42 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
43 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
44 subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

45 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
46 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
47 of this paragraph.

48 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
49 abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
50 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
51 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.

52 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
53 House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
54 thereof.

55 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2016.
