A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Morgan County High School's Class of 2015 International
2 Baccalaureate Diploma recipients; and for other purposes.

4 important objective of the General Assembly; and

5 WHEREAS, the International Baccalaureate program is a rigorous, off-the-shelf curriculum
6 recognized by universities around the world; and

7 WHEREAS, students in the International Baccalaureate program compete against 4,000
8 schools in the world spread across 147 countries; and

9 WHEREAS, the International Baccalaureate Diploma is designed for students of ages 16 to
10 19 who want to engage in career related learning; and

11 WHEREAS, the International Baccalaureate program encourages students to think critically
12 and challenge what they are told; is independent of governments and national systems, and
13 therefore able to incorporate best practice from a range of international frameworks and
14 curricula; and encourages students to consider both their local and international environment;

16 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia invests more than half of its revenue in the education of
17 future generations and looks to its academic scholars to be the leaders of tomorrow; and

18 WHEREAS, the class of 2015, Jessica Bailey, Mauli Desai, Mason DeVane, Johanna
19 Knowles, Hayden Massey, Madeline McCanless, Hannah Simpson, Griffin Sorohan, and
20 Claire Vinson have personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness, and
21 personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these remarkable students be
23 appropriately recognized.
