A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging the United States Senate to delay action on a new Associate Justice of the
- 2 United States Supreme Court until after the 2016 presidential election; and for other
- 3 purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Justice Antonin Scalia will go down in history as one of the most influential
- 5 jurists in generations; his legal mind was sharp and his legal opinions and commentaries were
- 6 accessible to non-jurists; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he was a champion of the originalist interpretation of the Constitution and
- 8 greatly helped to propel it forward in the legal community; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the country is in the midst of serious political division and a contentious
- 10 presidential election; and
- 11 WHEREAS, this being the case, it would be wise and prudent for the United States Senate
- 12 to wait until the presidential election is decided to confirm a new Supreme Court Associate
- 13 Justice; by waiting for the next president to be elected, a better and more complete picture
- will emerge of the direction in which the people want the country to move forward.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 16 encourage the United States Senate to delay action on a new Associate Justice of the United
- 17 States Supreme Court until after the 2016 presidential election.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 19 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
