A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Sergeant Zach Spahr; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Sergeant Zach Spahr was honored recently by Veterans of Foreign Wars Post
3 4180 during its annual Public Safety Awards ceremony for his outstanding service; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Sergeant Spahr had an honorable military career that included a slew of
5 recognitions and awards, serving in the United States Marine Corps and the Georgia Army
6 National Guard; and
- 7 WHEREAS, upon joining the Snellville Police Department in 2006, he was assigned to both
8 the Uniform Patrol Division and the Criminal Investigations Division and was named
9 Supervisor of the Year in 2014; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Sergeant Spahr was nominated by Chief Roy Whitehead for the Veterans of
11 Foreign Wars Public Safety Award based on his distinguished service; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
13 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
