A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Joe Kenny Boyett for his dedicated service to the Department of Corrections

3 WHEREAS, Joe Kenny Boyett was hired as a woodshop instructor at Ware State Prison in
4 July, 1999, and has served in that capacity for the past 17 years; and

5 WHEREAS, he has the remarkable ability to skillfully train and educate individuals about
6 woodworking, and because of his dedication, the wood shop on the grounds of Ware State
7 Prison has been named the Joe Kenny Boyett Wood Shop in his honor; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Boyett is known as a pioneer in the field of woodworking, and some of his
9 best craft includes cabinetry, wood carving, joinery, and carpentry; and

10 WHEREAS, before coming to Ware State Prison, he worked for the Ware County Board of
11 Education for 34 years, from 1965 to 1999, and is held in high regard; and

12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
13 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 commend Joe Kenny Boyett for his dedicated service to the Department of Corrections and
16 the State of Georgia and wish him continued health and happiness.
