A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Claudio Roberto de Barros Alencar and welcoming him to the United States;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Claudio Roberto de Barros Alencar of Brazil is visiting the United States from
4 April 18 to May 1, 2016, to learn about the Georgia General Assembly's legislative and
5 budgetary process; and

6 WHEREAS, he is a talented and well-regarded legislative coordinator, project manager, and
7 strategic planner who excels at building dynamic teams to achieve consistent goals and
8 identifying risks and adverse issues generated in budget and program activities and
9 recommending solutions to management; and

10 WHEREAS, his major accomplishments include being promoted to legislative coordinator
11 after just three years in the legislative assembly, implementing an analytical system to advise
12 the Appropriations Committee in the legislative assembly, investigating and analyzing
13 complaints to identify and resolve issues, and serving as a key contributing member to the
14 leadership team; and

15 WHEREAS, he has worked at the Legislative Assembly of the State of Pernambuco since
16 1998, and has previously served as a legislative fellow at Partners of the Americas, a project
17 manager for the Secretary of Tourism in Recife, a legislative coordinator for the Budget
18 Committee in Recife, and a professor at the Legislative School in Recife; and

19 WHEREAS, he attended ABA Global Education in Brazil, Living Learning English in the
20 United Kingdom, and the Federal University of Pernambuco and Federal University of Pará
21 in Brazil.

23 recognize Claudio Roberto de Barros Alencar, welcome him to the United States, and wish
24 him success on his journey.
