**AS PASSED SENATE**

**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act to supplement the salary of the judge of the Superior Courts of the Blue  
2 Ridge Judicial Circuit, approved February 8, 1950 (Ga. L. 1949-50, p. 102), as amended,  
3 particularly by an Act approved December 28, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, Nov.-Dec. Sess., p. 330),  
4 an Act approved March 2, 1966 (Ga. L. 1966, p. 119), an Act approved March 22, 1989 (Ga.  
5 L. 1989, p. 4192), an Act approved April 10, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 4447), and an Act  
6 approved May 5, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p. 4415), so as to change provisions relating to the  
7 amount of compensation paid to such judges by the county comprising the Blue Ridge  
8 Judicial Circuit; to provide for annual increases in the discretion of the governing authority;  
9 to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

10 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

11 **SECTION 1.**

12 An Act to supplement the salary of the judge of the Superior Courts of the Blue Ridge  
13 Judicial Circuit, approved February 8, 1950 (Ga. L. 1949-50, p. 102), as amended,  
14 particularly by an Act approved December 28, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, Nov.-Dec. Sess., p. 330),  
15 an Act approved March 2, 1966 (Ga. L. 1966, p. 119), an Act approved March 22, 1989 (Ga.  
16 L. 1989, p. 4192), an Act approved April 10, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 4447), and an Act  
17 approved May 5, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p. 4415), is amended by revising Section 1A as follows:

18 **"SECTION 1A.**

19 The governing authority of the county comprising the Blue Ridge Judicial Circuit, in its  
20 discretion, shall be authorized to increase the supplement provided in Section 1 of this Act  
21 no more than annually, and in such amount as fixed by the county governing authority."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 This Act shall become effective on October 1, 2015.

**SECTION 3.**

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
