## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Nathaniel Bronner; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Nathaniel Bronner was the first black student to graduate from Eckerd College  
3 with a degree in chemistry and is a current member of the Society of Cosmetic Chemists; and
- 4 WHEREAS, after graduating from college, he began work at his father's company, Bronner  
5 Bros., in the accounting department before he opened up the manufacturing division, where  
6 he increased annual product sales from \$200,000.00 to \$9 million; and
- 7 WHEREAS, his brother is now president and he currently serves as executive vice president  
8 of Bronner Bros., makers of top ranked BB Hair Products and other highly regarded items,  
9 which are now sold nationally in more than 25,000 stores and salons; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Bronner founded Century Systems, a multimillion dollar company  
11 specializing in the development and manufacturing of natural health products, and is a  
12 producer and teacher of The 24 Hour MBA, publisher of *MountainWings* and *Power Minute*;  
13 pastor at The Ark of Salvation, author of six books, the main movie critic of MovieFoot.com,  
14 and publisher of the popular weight loss and spiritual program, 42; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Bronner brothers received the 2014 Trumpet Award in Entrepreneurship;

- 17 WHEREAS, he is united in love and marriage to his wife, Simone, and is blessed with four  
18 remarkable sons, Nathaniel III, Josees, Christian, and George.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body recognize Nathaniel Bronner for his outstanding accomplishments  
21 and contributions to the State of Georgia.
