- 2 WHEREAS, the honorable Kwanza Hall is beginning his third term on the Atlanta City
- 3 Council representing District 2, the heart of Atlanta and the city's most diverse council4 district; and
- 5 WHEREAS, an Atlanta native and alumnus of Benjamin E. Mays High School, he attended 6 the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and he currently resides in the Martin Luther
- 7 King, Jr., Historic District; and
- 8 WHEREAS, prior to his election to the Atlanta City Council, Mr. Hall served on the Atlanta
- 9 Board of Education, and he currently serves on the boards of Leadership Atlanta, the Metro
- 10 Atlanta Arts Fund, the Atlanta Medical Center, the True Colors Theater Company, and the
- 11 Downtown and Midtown Improvement Districts; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in 2008, he was named one of Georgia Trend Magazine's "40 Under 40," and
- 13 in 2009, Creative Loafing named him Atlanta's "Best Local Political Figure"; and
- WHEREAS, in 2011, Atlanta's Park Pride honored Mr. Hall for governmental leadership in
  parks and greenspace advocacy, he was voted by an independent media panel as one of the
  100 Most Influential Atlantans, and Atlanta's American Institute of Architects chapter created
  the Kwanza Hall Award for civic leadership in architectural design; and
- WHEREAS, in 2012, Georgia State University honored him with the Pioneer Award, its highest recognition for leadership promoting arts and culture in downtown Atlanta, and in 2013, the W.K. Kellogg Foundation recognized his "Year of Boulevard" initiative to improve public safety and expand opportunities for families along District 2's Boulevard corridor; and
