A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jonathan Crowder, outstanding Georgia citizen and Eagle
2 Scout; and for other purposes.

4 served as an exceptional citizen and member of the prestigious Boy Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, his scouting career began as a Tiger Cub, and he has served as a faithful and
6 active member of the South Georgia Council of the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 WHEREAS, in an Eagle Scout Court of Honor ceremony, Jonathan will be awarded the rank
8 of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

18 WHEREAS, his perseverance and commitment to high morals and his community are further
19 demonstrated by his service as an outstanding student and the completion of an exceptional
20 community service project that consisted of organizing the installation of three benches
21 within his high school arboretum; and

22 WHEREAS, a great young leader, Jonathan Crowder has truly exhibited a commitment to
23 the scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
24 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

25 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
26 have brought great pride to his family, friends, and community, and this outstanding citizen
27 stands as a positive example for all Georgians.

29 the members of this body commend Jonathan Crowder for his diligence and dedication in
