A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Councilwoman Felicia A. Moore; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Councilwoman Felicia A. Moore was elected to the Atlanta City Council in
3 1997 and is serving her fifth term representing the citizens of District 9; and

4 WHEREAS, she currently serves as chair of the Committee on Council, is a member of the
5 Transportation and Finance Committee, and is president of the Georgia Municipal Black
6 Caucus, of which she is a co-founder; and

7 WHEREAS, she graduated cum laude from Central State University in Wilberforce, Ohio,
8 with a Bachelor of Arts in Communications, and she holds a Master of Science in
9 Administration with a concentration in Public Administration from Central Michigan
10 University; and

11 WHEREAS, Councilwoman Moore is an active member of the National League of Cities
12 (NLC) and a past president, past chair, and current board member of the National Black
13 Caucus of Local Elected Officials, a constituency group of the NLC; and

14 WHEREAS, as a participant of the NLC Leadership Training Institute, she has recently
15 earned the Diamond Ambassador Certificate Award; and

16 WHEREAS, one of her legislative highlights is the instrumental role she played in the July,
17 2011, Pension Reform for the City of Atlanta, and she is credited by many for bringing the
18 labor unions, pension boards, and employee groups together to agree on their increased
19 contribution level to save their Defined Benefits and avoid costly legal action against the
20 city; and

21 WHEREAS, Councilwoman Moore has received numerous honors and awards, including
22 being awarded the 2012, 2013, and 2014 Common Cause Democracy Award, being listed
23 in "Who's Who in Black Atlanta" and "The Women Looking Ahead 100 List," and being

24 recognized by the Atlanta Business League as one of "Atlanta's Top 100 Women of
25 Influence"; and

26 WHEREAS, she served as president of her neighborhood association for several years,
27 spearheading youth programs and crime watch and beautification efforts, and in 1995, she
28 was elected chair of Neighborhood Planning Unit-D and became a community advocate for
29 environmental, housing, and economic development issues.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
31 the members of this body recognize and commend Councilwoman Felicia A. Moore for her
32 dedicated public service and extend most sincere best wishes for continued success.
