1 Honoring Kathryn Parsons Willis; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, born and raised in Duluth, Georgia, Kathryn Parsons Willis graduated from
3 Duluth High School and Wesleyan College; and

4 WHEREAS, co-owner of Parsons Family Stores, where she worked for 61 years before
5 retiring, she is the founder of the Duluth Fall Festival, which is held annually on the Duluth
6 Town Green, attracting tens of thousands of visitors to Duluth; and

7 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
8 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state, as evidenced by her
9 superlative service on the Board of Directors of the Gwinnett Medical Center for 22 years,

12 Duluth; Ms. Willis is a faithful member of the Duluth First United Methodist Church and is
13 also active in numerous other civic organizations, always working toward the betterment of
