A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ms. Zelda Kennedy; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Ms. Zelda Kennedy, a native of Georgia, is an extremely talented and
3 world-renowned soprano who has performed across the United States and abroad, and whose
4 mesmerizing voice has been featured live on numerous radio and television events, including
5 the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Ecumencial Services; and

6 WHEREAS, she has traveled to such diverse places as Europe, Brazil, Israel, Bermuda,
7 Mexico, and the Caribbean, and performed as a soloist and concert artist in small intimate
8 venues and churches and large concert halls, cathedrals, and arenas; and

9 WHEREAS, Ms. Kennedy has been a featured soloist with orchestras and string quartets and
10 was extremely honored when the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra commissioned her to sing a
11 tribute to the late pioneer concert artist and opera singer, Marian Anderson, on the weekend
12 of her death; and

13 WHEREAS, she has received many accolades, including being named Goodwill Ambassador
14 of the United States' National Friendship Force under President Jimmy Carter, singing for
15 events at the Carter Presidential Library, and being presented with the Key to the City of
16 Montego Bay, Jamaica, for performances and outreach as a music workshop leader; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to being chosen by former Governor Zell Miller as his official
18 soloist, Ms. Kennedy was also a featured soloist for the inauguration of Atlanta's former
19 Mayor Maynard Jackson's second term; and

20 WHEREAS, Ms. Kennedy has performed for President William Jefferson Clinton,
21 Ambassador Andrew Young, media mogul Robert Edward "Ted" Turner III, and former
22 United States Surgeon General, Dr. Lewis Sullivan; and

23 WHEREAS, Ms. Kennedy has been honored to perform at birthday celebrations for
24 dignitaries such as United States Congressman John Lewis, Civil Rights Activist Reverend
25 Jesse Jackson, Sr., Civil Rights Leader Coretta Scott King, Broadcasting Executive Xerona
26 Clayton, and multimillionaire Norris Herndon; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body recognize and commend Ms. Zelda Kennedy for her numerous
31 achievements as a successful vocal artist.
