A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and congratulating Jared Bennett; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Jared Bennett, a junior at Lambert High School, and a member of Troop 1099,
3 in Cumming, Georgia, has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank
4 conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in Scouting must complete a
6 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected Scouting techniques
7 and attainment of the highest ideals of Scouting; and

8 WHEREAS, only one Scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and Jared
9 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
10 through the Boy Scout program; and

11 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man has demonstrated great leadership skills and
12 initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America program by serving as instructor,
13 patrol leader, and assistant patrol leader for his troop and attending the High Adventure Sea
14 Base in Florida in 2013; and

15 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Jared assisted in converting The Place food pantry
16 in Cumming to a client choice model, which entailed organizing and arranging the large
17 basement warehouse, setting up the pantry shopping area, and providing meal recipes with
18 available goods; and

19 WHEREAS, this June, he is attending the Young Dawgs Summer Science Internship at the
20 University of Georgia, a program designed to prepare high-achieving high school juniors and
21 seniors for postsecondary education and future careers; and

22 WHEREAS, Jared received the 2015 AP Scholar Award, and he is a member of the National
23 Honor Society, Science National Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta, Rho Kappa, and Beta
24 Club; and

25 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Jared has truly exhibited a commitment to the
26 Scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
27 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

28 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
29 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
31 the members of this body commend Jared Bennett for his diligence and dedication in
32 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on
