## A RESOLUTION

17 remarkable sons, Willem and Ewan; and
- 18 WHEREAS, her commitment to the community was further evidenced by her involvement  
19 with the start-up of a charter school; and

21 Central, Grant Central East Pizza, and Tomatillos; she is currently the president of her

22 family's small business, Kaiser Dough and Pizza Concepts; and she remains active in her

25 understanding of the concerns of downtown Atlantans, small business owners, school  
26 officials, and most importantly, Georgia families, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that
