#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending James Lambert; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, James Lambert has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished  
3 rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in Scouting must complete a  
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected Scouting techniques  
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of Scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one Scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and James  
8 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught  
9 through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 143 in Johns Creek,  
11 Georgia, and has demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the  
12 Boy Scouts of America program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, James served as a patrol leader and attended the Northern Tier National High  
14 Adventure; and
- 15 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, James has truly exhibited a commitment to the  
16 Scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a  
17 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 18 WHEREAS, James's project was to create a moveable wall to cover the storefront windows  
19 of a nonprofit organization, Corners Outreach, so that people passing by could not easily  
20 view the children in the facility; he collected \$2,460.00 for the necessary materials and put  
21 70 hours of his time toward his project; and

22 WHEREAS, in addition to the wall, he had a cabinet built for the girls' restroom and painted  
23 11 new tabletops to place on their outdoor tables with the assistance of other volunteers; and

24 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
25 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
27 the members of this body commend James Lambert for his diligence and dedication in  
28 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on  
29 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
