5 colleague of Pearlie Craft Dove, and she is dedicated to carrying forth the message of black
6 achievement in Atlanta; and
- 7 WHEREAS, she is a graduate of Oglethorpe University with a Bachelor of Arts in
8 International Studies, and she graduated from Le Cordon Bleu in London as a certified pastry
9 chef; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson is a community activist, and she is involved with multiple
11 community organizations, including her service as vice chair of the Neighborhood Planning
12 Unit-K in 2008, chair of NPU-K from 2009 to 2012, and zoning chair in 2013; and
- 13 WHEREAS, she was an Americorps participant in 2008, and she is involved with the J.B.
14 Whitehead YMCA; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson has been the executive director of the Conservancy at Historic
16 Washington since 2010, and she was the project manager for the 2015 Washington Park
17 Neighborhood Visioning Plan; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
19 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
