A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and congratulating the Inman Middle School Math Team; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Inman Middle School Math Team won the Second Annual Atlanta Public
4 Schools Middle Schools Math Competition, and the team's members placed first in every
5 category; and

6 WHEREAS, the competition included middle school math teams from Ralph Johnson
7 Bunche, Samuel Martin Inman, Martin Luther King, Jr., and Jean Childs Young, which all
8 squared off in a 90-minute match of intellectuality; and

9 WHEREAS, starting with the Individual Written Test, students were given 45 minutes to
10 respond to questions covering math topics, including the number system, expressions and
11 equations, functions, geometry, statistics and probability, and ratios and proportional
12 relationships, and the questions were meted out according to grade level; and

13 WHEREAS, following the first round of the competition, the math-letes advanced to the final
14 rounds of the competition involving the group ciphering round and the individual ciphering
15 round; and

16 WHEREAS, Martin Luther King, Jr., Middle School graciously hosted the tournament, and
17 the school's principal, Paul W. Brown, stated, "The power of mathematics provides an equal
18 opportunity for teamwork, partnership, and collaboration with unlimited potential for student
19 achievement," when asked about the importance of math in schools; and

20 WHEREAS, Atlanta Public Schools congratulate the outstanding middle school math teams
21 that competed this year and hope to see each of them participating again in the future; and

22 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of these
23 distinguished and remarkable students be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body recognize and congratulate the Inman Middle School Math Team
26 on their exemplary achievements in the Second Annual Atlanta Public Schools Middle
27 Schools Math Competition and extend best wishes for continued success.
