7 and chairman of the board of the Buford City Schools and oversaw the completion of the new
8 Buford High School; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he is highly involved in the community and has served as the director of the
10 Buford Basketball Association and chairman of the Gwinnett Convention and Visitors
11 Bureau and on the boards of United Community Bank, Gwinnett Convention and Visitors
12 Bureau, Gwinnett Chamber of Commerce, Georgia Gwinnett College, and the Gwinnett
13 Hospital System; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Tommy has also served as a member of Gwinnett Clean & Beautiful and is a
15 graduate of Leadership Gwinnett and the Regional Leadership Institute; and
- 16 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, he is a member of Buford First United
17 Methodist Church; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
19 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
