A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Dr. Herbert Wolfgang Eber; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Dr. Herbert Wolfgang Eber; and
- 4 WHEREAS, born June 2, 1928, in Vienna, Austria, he was sent to America by his
5 grandparents at the age of 11 years old; and
- 6 WHEREAS, adopted by his cousin, Beatrice Eber, and her spouse Issadore, he completed
7 high school and attended the University of Tennessee in Knoxville; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
9 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the Korean
10 War; and
- 11 WHEREAS, after the war, he attended the University of North Carolina, where he earned his
12 Ph.D., became an instructor at the University of Alabama, and was an active participant in
13 the Civil Rights Movement; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he relocated to Atlanta, Georgia, and started his own company, Psychological
15 Resources, writing programs and tests that other psychologists, prison systems, police
16 departments, universities, and individuals are still using throughout the country; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Dr. Eber was united in love and marriage to Juanita M. Eber and blessed with
18 three remarkable children, Deborah, Harry, and James; and
- 19 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Dr. Eber will long be remembered for his
20 love of family and friendship and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing
21 him.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Dr. Herbert Wolfgang
24 Eber and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.

26 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to his
