## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the formation and chartering of the Moore Middle School Leo Club; and for

5 friends, and develop valuable leadership skills; and

6 WHEREAS, the Leo Club's objective is to provide the youth of the world with an

9 WHEREAS, the club's motto is Leadership, Experience, and Opportunity; and

10 WHEREAS, Coach Jim Graver, previously a baseball coach at Abington High School in  
11 Pennsylvania and an active member of the Glenside Lions Club, started the Leo Club in  
12 1957, and in October, 1967, the club was adopted as an official program of Lions Clubs  
13 International by the board of directors; and

14 WHEREAS, the Leo Club Program has continued to grow within the last 50 years and now  
15 constitutes an international network of more than 6,500 clubs in more than 140 countries; and

16 WHEREAS, community service remains the cornerstone of the program, fostering a lifetime  
17 commitment to helping others, and like their Lion counterparts, members of the Leo Club  
18 enjoy serving their neighbors and watching positive results unfold.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body recognize the formation and chartering of the Moore Middle  
21 School Leo Club and extend most sincere best wishes for growth and success.
