

Senators Millar of the 40th and Henson of the 41st offered the following amendment:

**ADOPTED**

1 *Amend the substitute to HB 1025 (LC 43 0387S) by replacing lines 33 and 34 with the*  
2 *following:*

3 (B) Mailing a copy of it by registered or certified mail or statutory overnight delivery  
4 to the owner of such premises at the address of record maintained by the applicable tax  
5 commissioner. The certificate of mailing to the accused shall constitute prima-facie  
6 evidence of compliance with this subparagraph; and

7 *By replacing lines 36 through 39 with the following:*

8 (2) Service under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall not be authorized until there has  
9 been at least one attempt at personal service on the accused at the address of record of the  
10 accused as maintained by the applicable tax commissioner or of the accused's registered  
11 agent as maintained by the Secretary of State, provided that such attempt at personal  
12 service shall only be required if the accused resides or has a registered agent in this state.
