4 the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

16 Whitfield County Schools, where she has worked for the last 14 years and was twice selected
17 as paraprofessional of the year, most recently in 2015; and

18 WHEREAS, she is united in love and marriage to her husband of 36 years, Jim, and is
19 blessed with two remarkable children, Alex and Betsy; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
21 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body recognize and commend Susan Carter Lynch for her efficient,
24 effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia; congratulate her
