A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Chapter 33 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	health records, so as to provide that provisions relating to the costs of copying and mailing
3	patient records apply to psychiatric, psychological, and other mental health records; to
4	provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Chapter 33 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to health records,
8	is amended in Code Section 31-33-3, relating to costs of copying and mailing health records
9	and patient's rights as to records, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
10	"(c) This Code section shall apply to psychiatric, psychological, and other mental health
11	records of a patient."
12	SECTION 2.
13	Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 31-33-4, relating to mental health records,
14	as follows:
15	"31-33-4.
16	The provisions of this chapter, except as otherwise provided in Code Sections 31-33-3,
17	31-33-7, and 31-33-8, shall not apply to psychiatric, psychological, or other mental health
18	records of a patient."
19	SECTION 3.
20	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
