A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Dallas Gay on his outstanding public service; and for other
- 2 purposes.

- 3 WHEREAS, Dallas Gay has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
- 4 role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
- 5 citizens of Georgia; and

- 6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
- 7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state; and

- 8 WHEREAS, while a member of the Northeast Georgia Health Systems, Inc., Board, Dallas
- 9 Gay was instrumental in the "Think About It" campaign, a public education program
- 10 emphasizing steps to prevent medication abuse that has donated its proceeds to the Deaths
- 11 Avoided by Naloxone program which has saved many lives; and

- 12 WHEREAS, he initiated the Georgia 911 Medical Amnesty/Naloxone Law, which provides
- 13 immunity from certain arrests, charges, and prosecution for those seeking medical assistance
- 14 for a drug overdose and allows persons acting in good faith to administer an opioid
- 15 antagonist to a person at risk; and

- 16 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
- 17 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this
- 18 state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

- 19 WHEREAS, Dallas Gay has served with honor and distinction, and his vision and unyielding
- 20 commitment to making the State of Georgia a model on the fight and treatment of
- 21 prescription drugs and their many negative effects have set the standard for public service;
- 22 and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
24 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 recognize and commend Dallas Gay for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
27 public service to the State of Georgia and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued
28 health and happiness.
