

Senate Resolution 36

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to authorize the General Assembly to  
2 provide a fixed sum for funding the Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign  
3 Finance Commission; to provide that such funds shall not lapse; to provide for the  
4 submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI of the Constitution is amended by adding a new  
8 subparagraph (p) to read as follows:

9 "(p) An amount equal to 0.025 percent of the total state funds appropriated shall be  
10 appropriated in each appropriations Act to the Georgia Government Transparency and  
11 Campaign Finance Commission; and such appropriated amount shall not lapse as required  
12 by Article III, Section IX, Paragraph IV(c) and shall not be subject to the limitations of  
13 subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph."

14 SECTION 2.

15 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as  
16 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the  
17 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

18 "( ) YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to require the General  
19 Assembly to provide a fixed sum of the state budget to the Georgia  
20 ( ) NO Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission?"

21 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."  
22 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If  
23 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall  
24 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
