A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Walter B. Simmons on his outstanding public service; and for
2 other purposes.

4 the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service as teacher at Moses J. Jackson Elementary School,
9 of Savannah, as principal at the 38th and 37th Street Elementary Schools where he
10 championed integration, as director of middle schools, and later as an area assistant
11 superintendent of schools; and

12 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has given inspiration to many through his high
13 ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he possesses the vast wisdom
14 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
15 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

16 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
17 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

18 WHEREAS, Walter has received distinguished honors from his community, including the
19 dedication of the Walter B. (49) Simmons Gymnasium at the Frank Callen Boys and Girls
20 Club, his induction into Savannah's Athletic Hall of Fame, and having students at Moses J.
21 Jackson Elementary School name a street in the community, "Walter Simmons Court," for
22 him; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
24 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
