## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring and celebrating the life and memory of Mr. James Camp "Bimbo" Brewer; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
4 with the passing of Mr. James Camp "Bimbo" Brewer on January, 5, 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Brewer was born on May 29, 1943, in Gainesville, Georgia, his lifetime  
6 home; and

7 WHEREAS, he attended both the University of Georgia and North Georgia College before  
8 beginning his career with *The Times* of Gainesville and other pursuits; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Brewer was a gifted storyteller, historian, and colorful character who  
10 brought joy to the lives of everyone he knew; and

11 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, he was an active member of First Baptist  
12 Church of Gainesville, where he attained the rank of Eagle Scout, was an usher, Sunday  
13 School teacher, and an ordained deacon; and

14 WHEREAS, for 52 years, he was the devoted husband of the former Nancy Martin of  
15 Gainesville, loving father to Erin Brewer Still, and doting grandfather to Ben and Jackson  
16 Still; and

17 WHEREAS, he offered support and assistance to victims of criminal acts through the Hall  
18 County Sheriff's Office; and

19 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
20 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
21 family and friends were admired by others; and

22 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
23 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he  
24 made this world a better place in which to live; and

25 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Brewer will long be remembered for  
26 his love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, grandfather, uncle, and  
27 friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
29 join in honoring and celebrating the life and memory of Mr. James Camp "Bimbo" Brewer  
30 and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
