## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month and February 9, 2017, as  
2 Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol; and for other  
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations: CTI, Distributive  
5 Education Clubs of America, Future Business Leaders of America; Family, Career, and  
6 Community Leaders of America; Future Farmers of America; Health Occupations Students  
7 of America; SkillsUSA; and Technology Students of America; and career, technical, and  
8 agricultural education provide a solid establishment for the youth of America and the future  
9 of the business and economic development of our state; and

10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations promote occupational  
11 excellence, leadership, and citizenship among their members who are preparing for the work  
12 force and further education; and

13 WHEREAS, Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations are an integral and  
14 co-curricular component of the Career, Technical, and Agricultural Education programs,  
15 which are designed to support instructional objectives and attainment of academic and  
16 technical competencies; and

17 WHEREAS, they provide an opportunity for students to gain confidence and knowledge  
18 through competition and motivate youth to become better students and more productive  
19 citizens who, in turn, develop into school and community leaders; and

20 WHEREAS, February is officially recognized as Career and Technical Education Month by  
21 the Association for Career and Technical Education and the Georgia Association for Career  
22 and Technical Education.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
24 the members of this body recognize February as Career and Technical Education Month and  
25 February 9, 2017, as Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state
