A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and congratulating Sheriff Quinton Rush on the occasion of his retirement; and

3 WHEREAS, Quinton Rush has served with honor and distinction as Sheriff of Tattnall
4 County since being elected on January 1, 1997; and

5 WHEREAS, he has been an honest and dedicated public servant who strives for excellence
6 in all of his endeavors and whose primary concern is the welfare and safety of the citizens
7 of Tattnall County, Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, he is highly regarded by the citizens of his community and by state and local
9 government officials as a man of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the administration
10 of justice and sound principles of law enforcement; and

11 WHEREAS, this spirited law enforcement professional is an active member of the Georgia
12 Sheriff's Association and has exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty,
13 fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his duties; and

14 WHEREAS, Sheriff Rush's efficient and effective commitment to excellence has been
15 recognized by his peers through the many decorations and awards he has received, including
16 Officer of the Year with the Georgia State Patrol in 1983 and Georgia Sheriff of the Year in

18 WHEREAS, his inspiring commitment to the welfare of others is an outstanding example of
19 the positive effect law enforcement professionals have on the lives and well-being of others;

21 WHEREAS, Sheriff Rush is also active in the community outside of his office and selflessly
22 sponsors numerous fundraisers for children with cancer and serves as deacon at Oak Grove
23 Baptist Church; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that gratitude is expressed for the unique and
25 often unheralded contributions of local law enforcement professionals on behalf of the
26 citizens of this state.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 commend the care, courage, sympathy, and selfless dedication exhibited by Sheriff Quinton
29 Rush in carrying out the difficult duties of his vocation and congratulate him upon the grand
30 occasion of his retirement after 19 devoted years of service to Tattnall County.
