A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Gil Watson for his 23 years of dedicated service to the
2 Northside United Methodist Church and on the occasion of his retirement; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Dr. Gil Watson has spent most of his life
5 serving as a spiritual leader in his community and has held the position of senior minister of
6 Northside United Methodist Church for the past 23 years; and

7 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
8 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
9 dramatically by his superlative service with his ministry; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Watson has devoted his time to give support to the work of multiple boards,
11 including North Georgia Conference Board of Church and Society, North Georgia
12 Conference Committee on Education, Board of Pensions, Conference Worship Committee,
13 and North Georgia Committee on the Episcopacy, all committed to enhancing the
14 community; and

15 WHEREAS, he participated in the Malihambi Mission of the Methodist Conference of South
16 Africa, where he preached in the first racially integrated services in South Africa; and

17 WHEREAS, in 2007, Dr. Watson conducted Governor Sonny Perdue's inaugural prayer
18 service at Northside United Methodist Church and that same year offered prayer at the
19 Georgia Republican Convention; and

20 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
21 integrity, intelligence, faithfulness, and kindness; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Watson has served with honor and distinction with Northside United
23 Methodist Church, and his vision and unyielding commitment to his community and
24 congregation will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his retirement; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the tremendous efforts of this
26 distinguished leader and exemplary Georgian be appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 recognize and commend Dr. Gil Watson for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
29 pastoral service to the State of Georgia; congratulate him upon the grand occasion of his
30 retirement; and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued health and happiness.
