16 WHEREAS, Chief Cooper served with honor and distinction for 44 years, from 1972 to
17 2016, with the Martinez Volunteer Fire Department and Columbia County Fire Rescue, and
18 his unyielding commitment to overseeing the personnel and services offered to Columbia

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
21 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
