## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Lake Windward; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Lake Windward contributes significantly to the live, work, and play aspects of  
3 the community and to the corporate relocation and growth of the area; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Lake Windward's 196 acres is a haven to the thriving bass, brim, turtles, ducks,  
5 geese, grey heron, and other wildlife that make this lake their home; and
- 6 WHEREAS, water is a limited commodity and Lake Windward is a uniquely appealing and  
7 highly desirable amenity to the residences that surround its nearly seven miles of shoreline;  
8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, Lake Windward remains a tranquil oasis amongst the mid-rise office buildings  
10 that tower nearby, where recreational use is abundant for canoeing, kayaking, sailing, and  
11 electrified pontoons; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Lake Windward is the centerpiece of activity for the 2,428 households who  
13 access the lake for leisure boating, fishing, and recreational use from its marina and separate  
14 boat launch facility; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Lake Windward provides a quality-of-life complement to the adjoining  
16 Greenway Trail System and Alpharetta's network of sidewalks and bike lanes; and
- 17 WHEREAS, while Lake Windward is close to everything, its appeal is far from ordinary and  
18 it is a calming force and an anomaly not found in other dense and corporate communities.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 commend Lake Windward for its many valuable contributions on behalf of the citizens of  
21 Georgia.
