A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Deputy Kyle W. Dinkheller and dedicating an interchange in his
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law
4 enforcement officers with the tragic passing of Deputy Kyle W. Dinkheller on
5 January 12, 1998; and

6 WHEREAS, Deputy Dinkheller served as a member of the Laurens County Sheriff's Office
7 and his life was tragically cut short after he was murdered during a traffic stop; and

8 WHEREAS, he exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine
9 leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties; and

10 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
11 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an interchange in his honor.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
13 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the interchange at I-16 and Exit 42 (SR 338) in Laurens
14 County is dedicated as the Deputy Kyle W. Dinkheller, LCSO 37, Memorial Interchange.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
16 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Deputy Kyle W. Dinkheller,
17 LCSO 37, Memorial Interchange.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
20 family of Deputy Kyle W. Dinkheller and to the Department of Transportation.
