A RESOLUTION

12 liaison, senior outreach coordinator, Veterans Service Organization liaison, and also works
13 directly with the VA Medical Center director; and
- 14 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentlewoman has given inspiration to many through her high
15 ideals, morals, and deep concern for her fellow citizens, and she possesses the vast wisdom
16 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
17 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Dr. Tincie Marie Lynch has served with honor and distinction, and her vision
19 and unyielding commitment to fighting for those who risk their lives for the defense of the
20 world freedom have set the standard for public service; and
- 21 WHEREAS, we owe a debt of gratitude to our veterans and wish to express our appreciation
22 to all of our veterans for their selfless service to this state and the United States.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
24 commend Dr. Tincie Marie Lynch for her public service to the United States armed forces,
25 who risk their lives in the defense of freedom and to secure the blessings of liberty for this
26 nation, and recognize February 21, 2017, as Female Veteran's Day at the state capitol.
