## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Judge George Nunn on the occasion of his retirement; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Judge George Nunn has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for  
4 the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the  
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted nearly 30 years of his talents and  
7 energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced dramatically by his  
8 superlative service with the Houston County Superior Court; and

9 WHEREAS, a graduate of Emory Law School, Judge Nunn began practicing law with a  
10 private firm in Atlanta in 1969, and after 16 years of working as an attorney, he was  
11 appointed to the Houston County Superior Court by Governor Joe Frank Harris; and

12 WHEREAS, in 1996, Judge Nunn's acumen and integrity earned him the position of Chief  
13 Judge of the Superior Court, and throughout his service, he was designated to serve in place  
14 of a Justice on the Georgia Supreme Court three times; and

15 WHEREAS, Judge Nunn's significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable  
16 patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the  
17 citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and  
18 associates; and

19 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
20 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

21 WHEREAS, Judge Nunn has served with honor and distinction with the Houston County  
22 Superior Court, and his vision and unyielding commitment to the principles and practice of  
23 justice will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his retirement; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
27 GEORGIA that the members of this body recognize and commend Judge George Nunn for  
28 his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia;  
29 congratulate him upon the grand occasion of his retirement; and extend the most sincere best  
30 wishes for continued health and happiness.
